



The current price is 6.5% lower than the average price a month ago and 17.7% lower than the average price a year ago. The range of prices reported was as follows: Minimum price: R3.12 Maximum price: R4.50. Please note: Our methodology weighs the prices we collect according to the number of hides they sell in a month. This is done to make it more representative of the prevailing market price. NB* Hide
